As they climb the historic hotel staircase to their guestroom, doggies will be please to see a crate for them in the room. While their master is enjoying a meal in The Delmonico Room, dogs can enjoy a meal catered to their specific dietary needs. After a peaceful night of sleep, the hotel will arrange for dogs to be walked, and cared for while their owners antique shop and enjoy all the pleasures of Milford. To complete an already relaxing day, dogs can indulge in doggie-massages and grooming, including a shampoo and cut

with the latest pet products from Kiehl's – Cuddly Coat Grooming Shampoo, Cuddly Coat Conditioning Rinse and Spray-N-Play Cleansing Spritz. The Hotel Fauchère re-opened to the public in summer 2006. Five years in the making, the complex project adhered to rigorous U.S. Department of the Interior historic restoration guidelines, and the result is the transformation of a derelict building into an architectural gem at the center of Milford, which *Atlantic* magazine once called “the prettiest county seat in America”.

The restoration was led by Milford businessmen Richard L. Snyder and Sean Strub who sought to re-establish the Hotel Fauchère and its culinary reputation to what it was during the time of Louis Fauchère at the peak of the Gilded Era. Their effort is reflected in an elegant restoration with refined details, professional service and exquisite cuisine.

Guests and pets will stay at Hotel Fauchère for the dining experience alone. Under Chef Michael Glatz's direction, The Delmonico Room at Hotel Fauchère seats 50 and boasts a traditional yet modern menu with natural ingredients obtained from local and regional producers and the owner's own organic farm. The restaurant's décor includes a collection of fascinating vintage menus from the best-known restaurants in Europe in the 1920's. Chef Glatz selectively recreates these menus for today's modern palate paired with today's vintages of the suggested wines of the past. The Hotel's Bar Louis serves up a casual global cuisine from Thai Spare Ribs to the signature Sushi Pizza on it's bistro-style menu which also includes classic cocktails made with premium spirits in a sophisticated ambiance.

The hotel has 16 luxurious guestrooms which evoke the Fauchère's gracious past, while offering modern accoutrements, like high-speed wireless internet access, flat screen televisions, I-pod docking stations, Bose clock radios, heated towel bars and radiant heat in the marble and bluestone bathroom floors. Bed and bath linens are by Frette, the Italian manufacturer of fine linens and the skin and hair amenities are from Kiehl's. Room rates range from \$275 to \$350 (check website for special packages) and include a gift from the Chef, a bottle of wine and bottled water in each room, internet access and local calls, a deluxe continental breakfast and concierge services.
